1. Grace started with some tokens. Then 4 packs with 9 tokens in each pack were added, and 16 tokens were later lost. After those changes, Grace had 42 tokens. How many tokens did Grace have at the start?

2. Lucas opened 5 packs with 9 cards in each pack and then found 13 bonus cards. A partner group had 35 cards in all. How many cards apart were the two groups after the bonus cards were found?

3. Ella had enough markers to give 7 markers to each of 3 tables. Then 6 extra markers were found, and 5 markers were saved for tomorrow. How many markers were available to share after 5 were saved?

4. Chloe collected 21 tickets from one booth and 28 tickets from another booth. Then 1 ticket was added so the tickets could be shared equally among 2 teams. How many tickets did each team receive?

5. Ella had enough markers to give 10 markers to each of 6 tables. Then 8 extra markers were found, and 14 markers were saved for tomorrow. How many markers were available to share after 14 were saved?

6. Leo started with some tokens. Then 5 packs with 6 tokens in each pack were added, and 8 tokens were later lost. After those changes, Leo had 58 tokens. How many tokens did Leo have at the start?

7. Ella made 4 equal groups with 6 cards in each group and then added 9 more cards. Another class had 29 cards in all. How many cards apart were the two totals?

8. Ethan earned 6 bundles of tokens with 4 tokens in each bundle. After that, 10 bonus tokens were added. Later, a reward was unlocked, leaving 26 tokens. How many tokens came from the bundles before the bonus was added?

9. Mason collected 12 tickets in the morning and 22 tickets in the afternoon. Then 2 more tickets were added so the total could be shared equally. After that, the tickets were shared equally among 3 teams. How many tickets did each team receive?

10. Henry packed 2 boxes with 6 cards in each box and later packed more boxes for 8 cards altogether. The final collection was shared equally among 2 teams. How many cards were packed in the first set of boxes?
